Night Navigation Exercise 9 April

Our night nav ex proved to be much more difficult to get off for a number of reasons this year but it's done. The weather was one reason, but trying to get everyone together at another time was another. Being a nav exercise, I asked the Chief Nav for his input, he came back to me with a mission and patterns for each crew to perform at specific locations. In the day time this pattern would be a challenge, at night crews would be forced to rely GPS exclusively to stay on course in the pattern and in our business accuracy is what we strive for, day

or night. In preparation for this all the navs got together to plot out their own track and input it to the GPSs they would be using.

In class this worked fine, in practice some issues arose that we still need to work on. We need to

practise using it as a tool and we're only on an early step of the road, we need to be adept with this technology.

ELT Search St Andrews Airport 8 April

While in a meeting, Jerry Roehr received a call from JRCC Trenton about an ELT transmitting somewhere near Harv's Air Service in St Andrews. Employees from the airport, Harv's, and Keystone Air Service had been looking for the ELT without success for over an hour. Jerry and Jim Bell drove out to St Andrews and promptly located the ELT in the Advance Avionics shop in the Keystone Air hangar. The ELT had been checked previously, but it had an odd snag – the ELT could be switched off, but if it wasn't held in that position, it would continue to transmit.



Suspicion initially fell on the King Air parked beside the hangar, but the ELT was found in the shop, where it had been sent for maintenance.

First Aid Course Brandon 27 March

At the end of March, we were treated to a last second First Aid course at the Brandon Flying Club. We were hoping for 10 but could arrange 4 who had to eat for 10 - and do it quick before the local 6-toed bob-tailed hangar cat got to it. Being in Brandon also gave us a chance again to work closely with Zone 2 members. The course went fine with the new manual being more user friendly, smaller and with more photos. The biggest changes are in CPR

technique, start with 2 breaths, then focus on pumping blood with 30 fast compressions... 1, 2, 3 - 30. We also worked with an automatic defibrillator, there are pictures on the equipment to tell you where to place it and vocal instructions to follow, but it decides if it can shock or not. If you haven't been out to a first aid course in a while I'd strongly recommend going.

Missing Person Search Powerview / Sagkeeng 23 March

On the weekend of 20 March, a fourteen year old male went missing from Sagkeeng First Nation near Powerview. The male was reported missing on Monday afternoon, and we received a task on Tuesday afternoon. The crew, consisting of pilot Chuck Wilson, nav John Carley, and spotters Bill Evans and Danielle Gustafson, proceeded to Powerview and then along the Winnipeg River.

Upon overflying the search headquarters, they began a CLA along Highway 11. Having completed ten legs with no sightings, bingo was reached, and the aircraft returned to St Andrews, landing after three hours. A crew was requested to remain on standby for Wednesday, but by that time, the RCMP considered the case a criminal matter, and the second crew did not fly.
